Alan made a motion to use the AARP money for EMS/Fire payroll for Sheffield Township in the joint venture with Monroe Township will be authorized and shall be paid from the ARPA fund of \$82,873.37 for fire and emergency medical services. Ken 2nd. All in favor. Resolution #34. Discussed propane account and electric water heater — will wait for fall on propane.

Ken made a motion to approve up to \$1,300 to replace the hot water tank from gas to electric out of General 1000-110-599 other expense. Troy 2nd. All in Favor. Resolution #35 Tracy passed checks and purchase orders to sign.


Alan made a motion to return from executive session. Troy 2nd. All in Favor. Resolution #37
